Notification of Six Month Arrears Default of Debt Agreement

A debt agreement is terminated when:

- the debtor has made no payments within six months after a payment becomes due and payable; or
- the debt agreement has not been completed six months after the agreed completion date.

The administrator must notify the Official Receiver when they consider a six month arrears default has occurred. The Official Receiver verifies the information to ensure default has occurred and records the termination on the National Personal Insolvency Index.

The Debt Agreement Service notifies all parties to the agreement of the termination.

To be lodged

Within 10 working days of the six month arrears default.
