Approval for publication of a notice, and its contents, of the first meeting of creditors for the purposes of paragraph 64A(2)(a) and subsection 64A(3), as modified by Schedule 2 and Part 2, Schedule 6 of the *Bankruptcy Regulations 1996*

I, TERRENCE LEO GALLAGHER, Inspector-General in Bankruptcy, exercising my powers under paragraph 64A(2)(a) and subsection 64A(3) of the *Bankruptcy Act 1966*, as modified by Schedule 2 and Part 2, Schedule 6 of the *Bankruptcy Regulations 1996*, hereby approve the following requirements for publication of the notice, and its contents, of the first creditors meeting called under Division 6, Part IV and under an authority under section 188 of the *Bankruptcy Act 1966*.

This approval applies to a notice of the first meeting of creditors given on or after 3 April 2006.

For the purposes of publishing notice of the first creditors meeting, I approve the following requirements:


Notice of a meeting must be published in:

- (i) a national daily newspaper that circulates throughout Australia; and
- (ii) a regional daily newspaper of the State or Territory in which the debtor or bankrupt resides.

The minimum information for an advertisement must include the following matters:

- Meeting called under section 73 or pursuant to an authority under section 188
- Called to consider a proposal for a Part X Personal Insolvency Agreement or section 73 Composition or Scheme of Arrangement
- Bankrupt's or debtor's name, address, occupation, business name
- Controlling trustee's or trustee's name & address
- Time and date
- Place and address of meeting
- Contact details of the controlling trustee or trustee
- If first meeting of creditors called under an authority given under section 188 – creditors must be advised of Part X information available from ITSA
